Lesson Four – Holy Spirit – Summary & Questions

SUMMARY

READ THESE SCRIPTURES IN YOUR OWN BIBLE.

Acts 2:17-18 and Leviticus 23:15-16 – The Holy Spirit first became available to large numbers of people on the Old Testament holy day of FEASTS OF FIRST FRUITS or Pentecost. Pentecost means to count fifty.

Psalm 51:10-13 – David received moral strength by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Exodus 31:3 – God can give craftsmen talent by His power.

Ezekiel 36:26-27 – Christians keep the Law by the power of the Holy Spirit.

John 4:24 – God is spirit.

Acts 2:17-18 – Under the New Covenant, the Spirit of God is available in a universal way.

John 14:17 – Jesus promised the disciples the Holy Spirit after His resurrection.

John 14 – The Holy Spirit is called the Comforter.

Acts 2:38 and 8:12-17 – The Holy Spirit is imparted by the ceremony known as the Laying on of Hands. Read our doctrine on this subject [here](#).

Galatians 5:22-23 – Read about the fruits of the spirit that are created within you by the Holy Spirit.

1 Corinthians 2:16 – By the Holy Spirit we develop the mind of Christ.

1 Corinthians 2:7-14 – We cannot fully understand the plan of God or spiritual concepts without the Holy Spirit.

1 Corinthians 12 and Ephesians 1 – Through the Holy Spirit in us, we are assured of eternal life. It is an earnest of eternal life.

Romans 8:9 – The Bible says that without the Holy Spirit we are none of His.

Romans 8:14 – If we are led by the Spirit, we are the sons of God.

2 Corinthians 4:16 – We are renewed day-by-day by the Holy Spirit.

Acts 2:38 and Acts 8:12-17 and 2 Corinthians 5:4 – A convert to Christianity at baptism is begotten by the Holy Spirit.
